

Sister Agricola Zumdick (Antonia Zumdick)

Sister Agricola Zumdick was born in Handorf bei Münster, Westfalen, Germany on August 14, 1891. Her parents were William and Gertrude Fischer Zumdick. Sister Agricola entered religious life at Nonnenwerth, Germany in 1904 and professed her vows at Nonnenwerth on April 4, 1907.

Sister Agricola came to the United States in 1907. She worked as a housekeeper, cook and laundress throughout her religious life. She worked in Minot, North Dakota for most of her life, but also spent some time at Holy Rosary Mission. She died at St. Joseph's Hospital, Minot, North Dakota on May 13, 1940. She is buried in St. Leo's Cemetery, Minot.
