Sister Armella Orlowsky-Meyer (Mary Orlowsky)

Sister Armella was born on November 19, 1869 to Joseph and Maria Lechkowsky Orlowsky in Rosenberg, Germany. In June 1882, she arrived in the United States. She entered the Sisters of St. Francis on October 5, 1888 at Sacred Heart, Buffalo, New York. Sister Armella professed her vows on August 1, 1893, at Sacred Heart, Buffalo.

Sister Armella spent her religious life as a laundress and served in St. Agnes, Alliance, Nebraska and St. Mary's, O'Neill, Nebraska. She retired to St. Joseph's Hospital, Minot, North Dakota. Sister Armella died on June 25, 1945 at St. Joseph's Hospital, Alliance, Nebraska. She is buried in Calvary Cemetery, Alliance.
