Sister Natalia Perzylo was born in Milkov, Poland on September 6, 1895. Her parents were Gregory and Rosa Katcher Perzylo. Sister Natalia entered the Sisters of St. Francis on February 2, 1920 at Stella Niagara, New York. She professed her vows at Stella Niagara on August 13, 1923.
