

Sister Godeline Luxen (Elizabeth Luxen)

Sister Godeline Luxen was born on September 6, 1884 in Olzheim, Germany. She entered the Sisters of St. Francis at Nonnenwerth Germany on September 30, 1905 and professed her vows on August 23, 1909 at Stella Niagara, New York.

Sister Godeline came to the United States in June 1907. She was employed as a cook and housekeeper in various places in Holy Name Province. In Sacred Heart Province, she served at Holy Rosary Mission, South Dakota, St. Agnes, Alliance, Nebraska, St. Joseph's, Minot, North Dakota and Marycrest, Denver, Colorado.

Sister Godeline retired as a convalescent to St. Joseph's, Alliance, Nebraska in 1943. She died January 18, 1956 at St. Joseph's Hospital, Alliance, and is buried in Calvary Cemetery, Alliance.
