Sister Caritas Paull (Rosa Paull)

Sister Caritas Paull was born in Exeter, Nebraska on July 8, 1891. Her parents were John P. Paull and Frances Jung Paull. Sister Caritas was the eldest of three blood sisters who became Sisters of St. Francis. Sister Caritas entered the novitiate at Stella Niagara on August 3, 1909 and professed her vows on March 25, 1913.

Sister Caritas served as a teacher. She earned her BA degree in 1920 from Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska. She held teaching certificates in the states of New York and Nebraska. She taught at St. Agnes Academy, Alliance, Nebraska a total of twenty-three years. She also taught at St. Leo's, Minot, North Dakota.

In 1956, Sister Caritas retired to Alliance, Nebraska. She died on January 14, 1958 at St. Joseph's Hospital, Alliance, Nebraska. She is buried in Calvary Cemetery, Alliance.
