Sister Fides Paull (Lillian Paull)

Sister Fides Paull was born on April 8, 1894 in Neligh, Nebraska. She was the daughter of John P. Paull and Frances Jung Paull. She entered the novitiate on July 22, 1911 and professed her vows on September 5, 1914.

Sister Fides was the second of three sisters who entered the Sisters of St. Francis. Like her sisters, she was a life-long teacher. She earned her BS degree in 1927 from Canisius College, Buffalo, New York. In 1948 she was awarded her MS degree from Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska. She taught in St. Mary's, O'Neill, Nebraska and St. Agnes Academy, Alliance, Nebraska.

Sister Fides died of a heart attack at Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska on August 1, 1959. She is buried in Calvary Cemetery, O'Neill, Nebraska.
