

Sister Theola Vetter (Isabelle Vetter)

Sister Theola Vetter was born on September 23, 1901 in Marathon, Wisconsin. She was the daughter of Frank and Frances Sauter Vetter. She entered religious life at Stella Niagara, New York on September 15, 1927. She professed her vows on August 16, 1930 at Stella Niagara.

Sister Theola was a nurse and earned her RN certificate from St. Joseph's Hospital, Omaha, Nebraska in 1923. In 1938 she received her BS in nursing from the College of St. Theresa, Winona, Minnesota.

Sister was nursing supervisor at St. Joseph's Hospital, Minot, North Dakota. She died on January 5, 1974. At the time of her death she was the Assistant Director of Nursing at St. Joseph's Hospital. She is buried in St. Leo's Cemetery, Minot, North Dakota.
