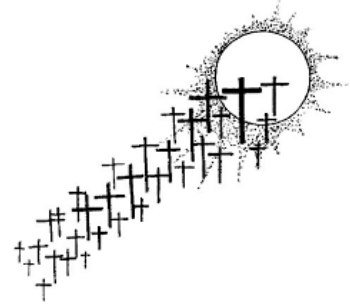
**PLEASE PRAY FOR THE REPOSE SOUL OF:**
