# **MESSAGE FROM LCWR:**

LCWR has been working with the Asociación de Hermanas Latinas Misioneras en América (AHLMA), the Conference of Major Superiors of Men (CMSM), the Mexican American Catholic College (MACC), and the Religious Brothers Conference (RBC) to create a one-week program for women and men religious who are serving in direct ministry with persons who are seeking hope as they live with trauma and fear. With the support of a generous grant, 40 religious may participate in this experience of input, reflection, and conversation at a cost of only \$50 per person, plus transportation.

The program will be held from May 15-20, 2022, at Bon Secours Retreat and Conference Center in Marriottsville, Maryland and will be led by Pat Farrell, OSF and Mary Elaine Anderson, IHM in English and Spanish.

Applications for the program must be received by November 15, 2021, and those who have been accepted for participation will be notified by December 7.
