COVID: ST. FRANCIS PROVINCE LEADERSHIP TEAM:

Dear Sisters, Associates & Friends,

As many of you know, Sisters Maria Elena and Debbie have recently been in Assisi for the IFC-TOR Assembly. While there last week, there was an outbreak of COVID in the gathering of 96 people from many countries all over the world. During the last 24 hours of the assembly, five people tested positive for COVID. They were put into isolation. Sisters Maria Elena and Debbie had been experiencing "allergy-like" symptoms for a few days prior to the outbreak, plus they were under a lot of pressure with late nights, and with the burden of assembly responsibilities with Sister Maria Elena facilitating and Sister Debbie winding up her Presidential role of IFC-TOR. All this to say that they were vulnerable and, looking back, that contributed to the diminishment of their immunity systems. When they returned to Rome on May 17 they promptly got tested and both have tested positive for COVID.

At present Sisters Maria Elena and Debbie are isolated at the Generalate and being well cared for by the Sisters there. The physical symptoms are still allergy-like and have not worsened. Both are very tired physically, emotionally, and psychologically and in need of restorative rest and recuperation.

The protocol for the airlines is that there must be an isolation period of 11 days before flying. Flight reservations to return together to San Francisco on May 31st have been made.

This morning Sisters Maria Elena and Debbie are on a Zoom call with our Care Coordinators Carrie and Nanor in order to get reliable information, guidance and encouragement from these two great medical women on our team. We are very grateful for their care, expertise, and generosity in responding to our needs.

Please know that they are doing what they can to enter into this new reality which, needless to say, affects all of us. Please pray for and with Sisters Maria Elena and Debbie as well as all the other folks at the assembly who became sick and those who may subsequently become ill.

Specific to Sisters and Associates, the Sacred Exchange which was scheduled for tomorrow, May 20, is cancelled. Look for more information next week. We are rescheduling it to May 27th.
