FROM MARY HELP OF CHRISTIANS PROVINCE, POLAND:

Below is a letter of gratitude from Sr. Majella Lizińczyk (Provincial Minister), from our sister province, Mary Help of Christians Province, Brusy, Poland.

Dear Sister Maria Elena (St. Francis Province, Provincial Minister) and dear Sisters,

My sincere greetings and many thanks for your great care and love, for your big heart for all those in need and harmed by the war in Ukraine. Thank you for your solidarity and assistance to the refugees from Ukraine. Already in the first days after the outbreak of war in Ukraine, about 40 people from Ukraine, mainly mothers with children, found shelter and all possible help in our communities; the largest number in

Czestochowa - more than 20 people. The situation was and still is very dynamic. The number of people in our communities constantly changed; some left, others came from Ukraine. Most of these people, during the holiday season despite the dangerous situation in Ukraine, left for their hometowns, but many of them want to return to Poland in September so that their children can continue their education in Poland.

We would like to thank you, dear Sisters, for the financial aid donated already in the first weeks of the war for the refugees from Ukraine - thanks to this we were able to support more those who lived and still live with us, as well as support other initiatives for the refugees we meet in our places of work, such as in schools (buying food, clothing and shoes), paying for the stay in a resort by the sea for 3 people from Ukraine (thanks from them attached).

Thank you for your continued financial assistance and donation of another amount to help refugees. I think that from September, we could support them in settling in Poland (many mothers with children are planning a longer stay in Poland, but want to become independent, which in the absence of material resources is difficult), as well as support those who, longing for loved ones and the homeland, return to Ukraine, although all their possessions are destroyed, and they have to start all over again.

Everyone hoped that the war in Ukraine would end quickly, but the reality proved otherwise. Thank you for being with us and for opening your hearts to the afflicted and affected by the war in Ukraine.
