Sacred Heart Community's archive and archivist, Holly Fiedler, are part of a future initiative called the Franciscan Central Archive (FCA). This initiative is to plan how best to preserve and safeguard Franciscan archives and legacies. Their vision statement is the following:

A sustainable, charism-based collaborative repository for the combined archival collections of Franciscan entities across the United States.

With the FCA, they have found a way to have the archival collections of the North American communities of the Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity (Sacred Heart Community, St. Francis Province, and Holy Name Province) come together when necessary and be cared for in perpetuity.
